

# Switzerland East-West WUCA Record Attempt by Eliane Zimmermann on May 29th & 30th 2021

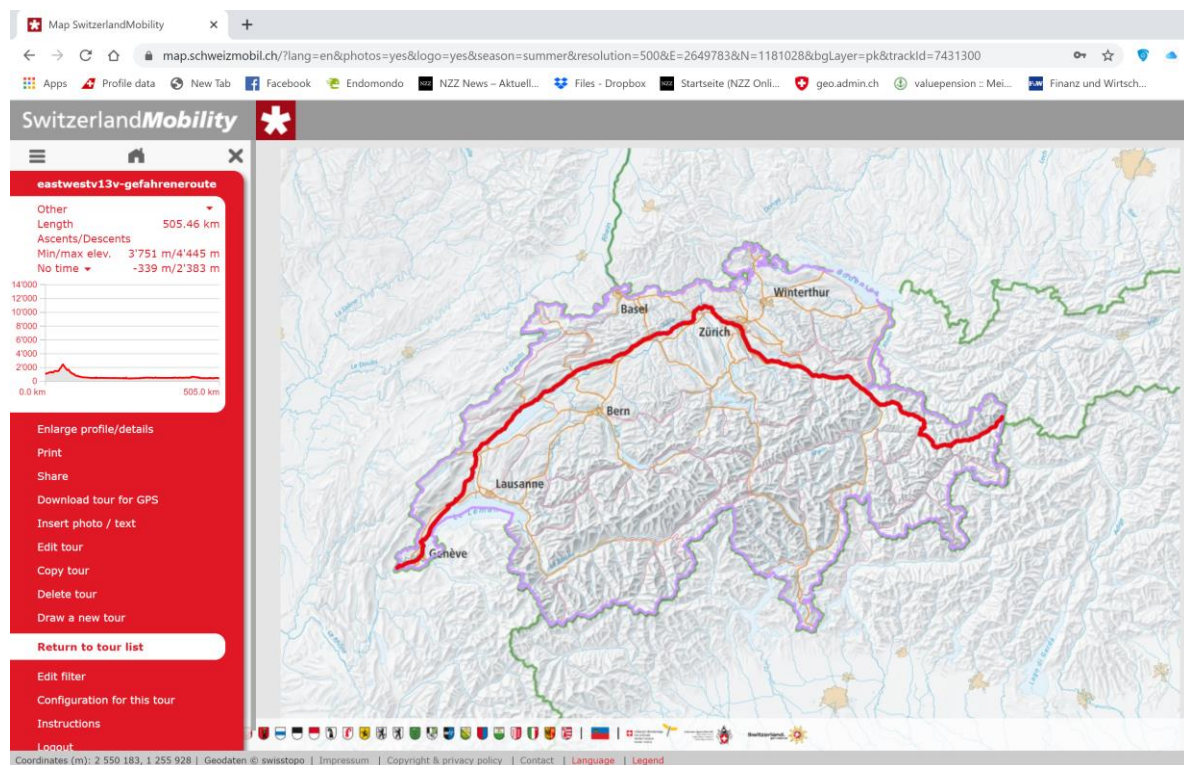
This is a new record as there was no other woman yet doing this attempt.

## Routing

The routing was long discussed and different routes were looked at. After talking to Simon Ruff and studying the route of his attempt in 2020, it was decided to take the same route.

The route was then followed until shortly before Geneva (at the beginning of Versoix) where Simon had to take a slightly different route due to road work. We could carry on at the lake side.

The route was planned to be about 505 km and without the closed road at Versoix it was 502 km.



## Tracking

Tracking was done with the Garmin 1030 on Eliane's bike.

## Adherence to WUCA Rules

Cyrril Kobler and Michael Lehmann were the WUCA officials and one of them was all the time in the follow vehicle that was following Eliane.

Handouts were made from the PSV or at a stop off the road.

At the lake of Walensee following the rider was not possible from Murg as there is only a small bike-road without any chance to follow the rider. Therefore, the PSV made a leapfrog and the rider was met again at Bilten.
